



Business FAQ



What do businesses need to participate in Made in Monmouth events?

To participate in Made in Monmouth events, businesses must make a consumer product in Monmouth County, be registered with the State of New Jersey, and have a tax ID number. Businesses that make a consumable product must have a health inspection certificate or cottage food license from the health department. Only products made in Monmouth County can be sold at Made in Monmouth events.

How can businesses create an account on www.madeinmonmouth.com?

To create an account, go to www.madeinmonmouth.com and click business sign in on the top right-hand corner. Click 'create one here' to create a new account. Enter your business' information. The fields marked with a red asterisk are required. When you are finished click 'finish'. Your submission needs to be reviewed and approved by the Division of Economic Development staff before being published on the website. You can sign in any time to update your information. Not all businesses listed on the business directory are registered for a Made in Monmouth event.

How to register your business for Made in Monmouth events?

Go to www.madeinmonmouth.com and click 'business sign-in' to the top right-hand corner. Sign into your account. Once you sign-in, click 'events'. Click to 'register for the event'. Answer the questions on the form and then click 'register'.

The Made in Monmouth team will review your registration and email you to confirm your participation. You must have an account on the Made in Monmouth website to register for an event.

How can I reset my password?

If you have forgotten your password, click 'business sign-in' then 'forgot password'. Enter your email and the security code. An email to reset your password will be sent to you.

Do I need to bring a table to Made in Monmouth events?

No. Businesses are provided with one six-foot table and two chairs. You may **NOT** bring any additional tables—regardless of how small they may be—into the building. You may bring small, narrow display racks or shelves that can fit **behind** your table if they do not interfere with neighboring businesses or impede public access. Vendor table locations will be randomly assigned and located throughout the venue.
